March's Events

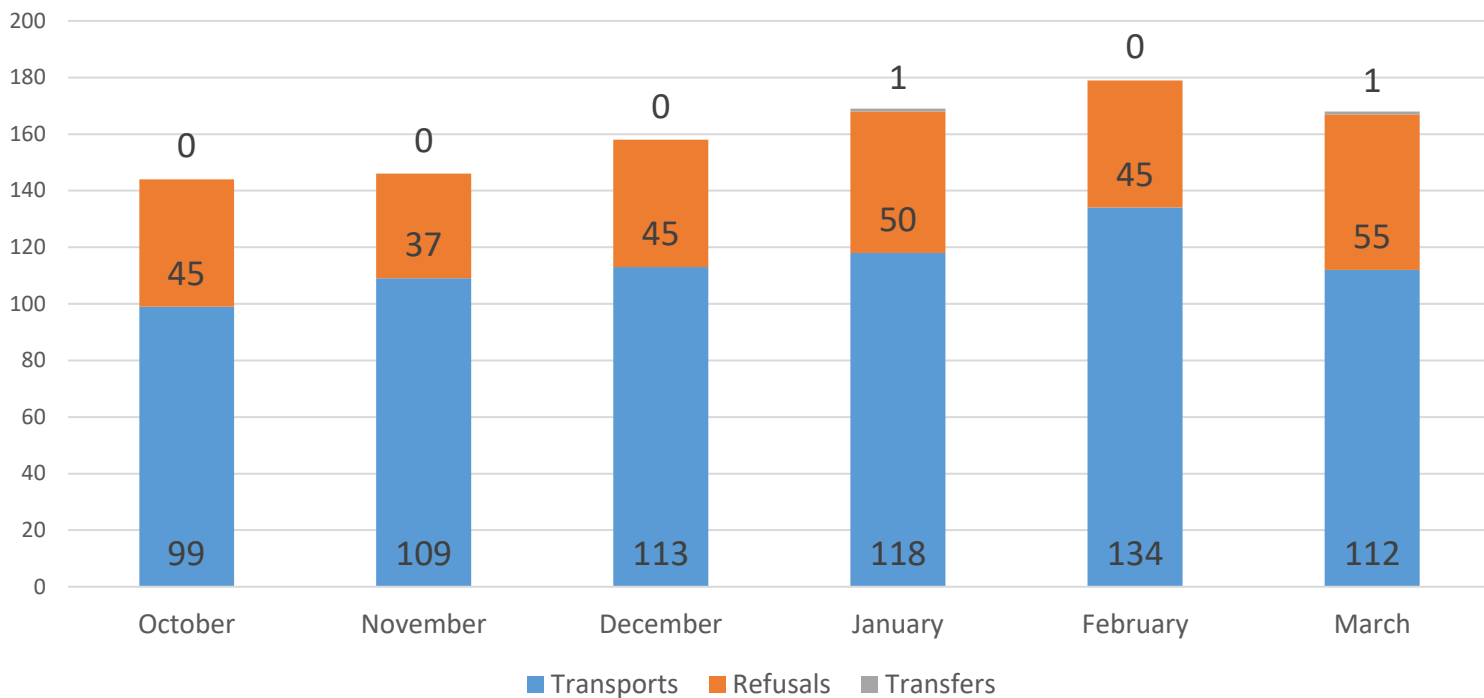
- Public CPR Training – Jones Dental employees were provided BLS refresher training through the District.
- Recognition at Dallas City Council – A few local fire agencies recognized Kent McKnight at the Dallas City Council meeting. Kent is the shop manager and has a huge positive impact on the maintenance of our apparatus.
- Grand Ronde MCI Exercise – Chief Ehrmantraut was asked to observe and evaluate a MCI exercise at Spirit Mountain Casino.
- Salem Health Quarterly Meeting – Leadership at Salem Hospital meets quarterly with EMS agencies to collaborate on projects that improve the quality of service provided to citizens.
- EMS Committee - The District has a committee of line staff that meets bimonthly to provide input on current processes and equipment used to provide EMS services. This group also serves as PCFD's EMS Quality Management group.
- Chemeketa EMS Program Advisory Committee – This group meets quarterly to provide input on the Chemeketa EMS program as part of their accreditation requirements.
- Pediatric Advanced Life Support – Select personnel attended this AHA certifying class taught by District staff to review standards for treating children suffering from cardiac and respiratory illnesses.
- Advanced Cardiac Life Support – Select personnel attended this AHA certifying class taught by District staff to review standards for treating life-threatening cardiac issues in adults.
- Polk County Youth Conference – The District presented to a large group of county high school seniors about entering the EMS profession.
- Polk County ASA Meeting – This was the first meeting since the County's release of the draft ASA plan. The meeting focused on editing the draft to meet the needs of the County's citizens.
- EMS Drill – An outside instructor taught IO training to District ALS providers. Captain Shellito instructed BLS providers and new recruits on foundational skills.

Apparatus Updates

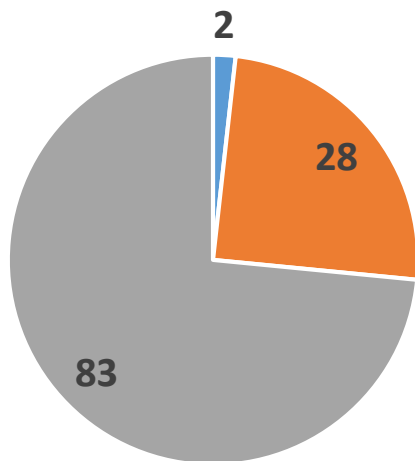
- E92 – Several small fixes that were caused by normal wear and tear.

EMS Call Types

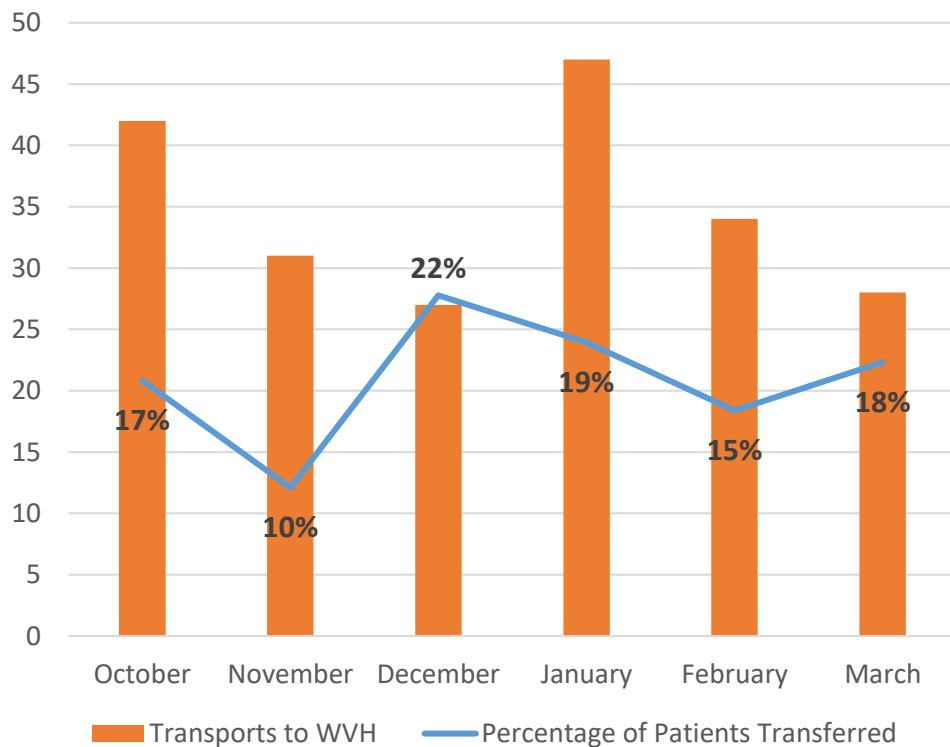


Transports by Destination
